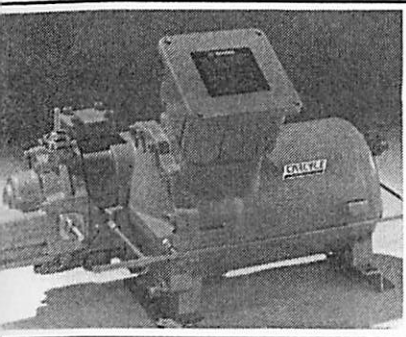

... **William H. Clark II, P.E.**, an engineer with O'Connell Robertson and Associates in Austin, Texas, who has been named to the *Who's Who in the Southwest*.

Clark is an honors graduate of the University of Texas at Austin, where he was an Engineering Scholar. He was preparing a text for the BNP Technical Book Division on energy conservation projects in existing buildings.

Clark is a member of ASHRAE, IES, and ASME, where he is the technical chairman of the Geothermal Energy Committee. He is also an advisor to the Home Energy Rating Systems Council, and to the Building Environment and Thermal Envelope Council of the National Institute of Building Sciences.

In addition, Clark provides daily energy-conservation tips to the Austin newspaper; has a daily energy-conservation spot on a local AM station; and has written many magazine articles on energy topics.

He recently presented three technical papers at the Hot and Humid Climate Building Symposium in Dallas on energy-saving computer programs, and will present four more at the Intersociety Energy Conversion Engineering Conference in Monterey, Calif., in August, on geothermal topics.

Cuomo spent nearly an hour walking the floor of the Syracuse, N.Y., plant and warehouse and chatting with some of the division's 410 employees before he made the award presentation.

During his tour, Cuomo watched as a skin-wrap machine spun a web of black plastic around a load of motors on the floor. He whispered to Ray Harrington, the machine operator. Harrington nodded in agreement. Then the governor took a pen and scrawled the message, "Wrapped by Mario Cuomo," onto the back of his business card and tucked it inside the black wrapper. Harrington said the order was headed for Carrier Bock in Irving, Texas.

In his formal remarks, Cuomo predicted U.S. companies will continue to rebound against foreign competition as long as they apply innovation, technology, and superior knowledge.
